SERVICES



RESIDENTIAL VISITS

- Basic physical assessment (vital signs, heart/lung sounds, etc.)
- Home safety assessment and recommendations
- On-call for non-emergency medical needs



- Administration of MD ordered IM injections (B12, hormones, etc.)
- Assistance with home medications (pill planner set-up, basic education)



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CHRONIC ILLNESS FDUCATION

 Assistance with management of chronic diseases such as congestive heart failure, diabetes, and hypertension

CARE COORDINATION

- Information on transitioning loved one from home/self care to longterm care (Info on skilled and nonskilled home care, assisted living facilities vs. skilled nursing facilities, Hospice)
- Coordinate in-home private sitters
- Coordinate transport needs
- Loan out free durable medical equipment (DME)
