# BENEFITS OF DAILY BIBLE READING

One of the vital habits of a deepening spiritual life is reading the Bible on a consistent, if not daily, basis. Most believers quickly acknowledge the Bible as God's Word, which reveals God's will and provides instruction for life, but they also admit their struggle in finding the rhythm of reading the Scriptures regularly. This booklet is a tool to help in your pursuit of reading the Bible consistently as a part of your spiritual growth.

How does daily Bible reading impact us?

- **It draws us to God**— We never know the heart and will of God without the Word of God, so consistent Bible reading keeps us focused on Him. We may never fully retain every verse we read or every story we encounter in the Scriptures, but returning to the Bible daily reminds us of God's work and draws our attention to Him.
- **It creates discipline**— One of the truths I've taught our congregation over the years says, "Spiritual growth happens daily, but not in a day." This means that we grow closer to Christ by daily disciplines and decisions that become the course and contour of our spiritual lives. Using a tool like this booklet, along with checking off daily reading assignments, assists us in creating the daily disciplines that take us to new depths of spiritual growth.

• **It recenters our heart**— I encourage people to find a time early in the day, if not one of the first activities of the day, to read the Bible. Before the stress and strain of daily commitments start to roar, and before the white noise of email, social media, and digital communication deafen us, a quiet time of daily Bible reading recenters our heart and mind upon the Lord. Each day is a reminder of His renewing grace, and starting the day off with the Scriptures refocuses and recenters our heart on Him who loves us the most.

May the Lord use His word to take you higher and deeper in His grace as you engage the Scriptures each day.

# KEYS TO SUCCESSFUL BIBLE READING

If you want to spend consistent, daily time in the Scriptures, don't forget these three keys to success:

## **Designated Time**

God clearly is not bound by time and space, and you can spend time with Him whenever you want; but choosing a designated time reinforces the rhythm of spiritual growth while building a stronger habit. Possible times might be first thing in the morning before the day begins, at noon during a quiet lunch break, or at some free time in the evening. The key is to choose the same time each day and stick to it.

## **Designated Place**

Find a quiet place where you will read the Scriptures each day, and use the same place each time. Whether it is your kitchen table, the back porch, or in your office before people arrive, make that your sacred space for meeting with the Lord.

## **Designated Plan**

Too many people don't have a plan when they spend private, personal time with the Lord, and they are not certain where to begin or how to end. This booklet is a basic plan to help you build the discipline of daily time in God's Word, which creates a habit as part of the spiritual rhythms that are part of a vibrant faith.
